Bacha bazi (Persian: ??? ?????, lit. 'boy play'), refers to a pederastic practice in Afghanistan and in historical Turkestan, in which men exploit and enslave adolescent boys sometimes for sexual abuse, and/or coercing them to cross-dress in attire traditionally only worn by women and girls. The man exploiting the young boy is called a bacha baz (literally "boy player"). Typically, the bacha baz forces the bacha (young boy) to dress in women's clothing and dance for entertainment.

The song remains one of the most popular Bengali song of all time and is a common tune heard in Bangladeshi households. The term hippie was used in print by San Francisco writer Michael Fallon, helping popularize use of the term in the media, although the tag was seen elsewhere earlier.
